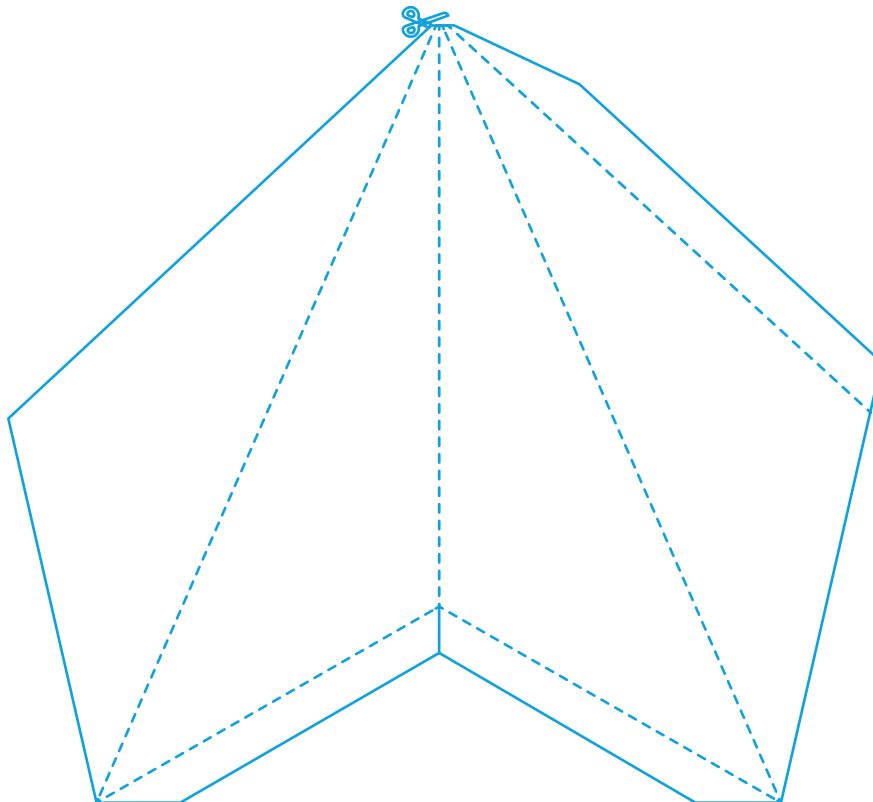


How to make a Greeting Card Star



Materials required:

5 MOO Greeting cards
Glue
Scissors
Paper folder (bone folder)
Ruler
Pencil

1. Making the template. It's advisable to print the template and draw around it. Make marks for both cut lines and fold lines, assuring that you make your marks on the inside of the card and think about which part of the design you'd like to see on the finished star (and make sure that you aren't chopping a little bird in half!) Cut out your five shapes.

2. Score along the folding lines using a bone folder to give crisp folds. You could also use an empty ball-point pen, or even a butter knife if you don't have a bone folder.

3. For each of the five shapes, mountain fold along the long lines and glue the long edges together. This will form the points of the star. Valley fold the little tabs at the base of each point.

4. Now for the assembly. Take two points, run a thin line of glue onto the tabs, and attach this to the next point.

5. Repeat the previous step for each of the points until you have formed a star. The last point is a bit fiddly. Give the star a good squish, to make sure that the glue is evenly applied. And voila! You have made a star because you are a star!
